South has a minimum hand. 5-2-2-4. His partner knows he has $5 \boldsymbol{\sim}$ and $4 \boldsymbol{\pi}$. With this hand South should simply bid $4 \vee$ saying, I have the A but I don't particularly like my hand. I do not have the $\mathrm{A} *$ or the $\mathrm{A} \star$. North knows that South does not like his hand and has no diamond control and should simply bid 4A.


North/South are in a game forcing auction, below the four level. Therefore Serious 3 N would apply.

South has a medium hand. 5-2-1-5. His partner knows he has at least $5 \boldsymbol{\sim}$ and $4 \curvearrowleft$. With this hand South should bid Serious 3 N asking partner to cue bid. North will bid $4 \vee$ and South will try for slam.

North will cue bid the A * and South will bid 4NT - Key Card for Hearts. when they find they are off two key-cards they will sign off at $5 \bullet$


North South are in a game forcing auction below the game level. This is a hand where Kevin and I would use 'Serious $2 A^{\prime}$.

Over $2 \vee$ south would bid $2 \uparrow$ saying 'given the auction, I like my hand'. North would cue-bid $3 \boldsymbol{*}$. South would cue bid 3 * showing the $\mathrm{A} \bullet$. At this point, with no other control to cuebid and a minimum point count for the auction North would simply bid $4 \vee \ldots$...nothing else to tell you'.

South would know that North had no spade control and probably no diamond fitting card and simply pass.
